### Launch of school bus for girls at Dahej:

Non-availability of the high schools in villages often leads to the drop-out of the girl child after the primary education. To deal with this issue in the surrounding villages near its factory at Dahej, SRF extended one staff bus for school children, especially girls, to commute from Suva & Jolva village to the nearby Dahej high school, 12 kms away. This has improved the regularity and retention of girl students in the high schools as compared to the previous years.
